this coffee is a microlot separation, and comes to us from approximately 3800 small-holder members of the kirema washing station cooperative, located in the kayanza region of burundi.

the kirema washing station operates 35 collection centers around kayanza, allowing farmers to bring cherry to the center closest to their farm. nearly all of these farmers practice polyculture, raising multiple other crops, including bananas, beans, sweet potatoes, cassava, and taro.

this coffee is grown at an average of 1880 meters. it is fully washed, and the coffee is dried on raised beds. it consists of the bourbon variety, along with the bourbon derivatives jackson and mibirizi.
