this is a fair trade certified™ coffee grown near nuevo paraiso in the chiapas region of mexico by approximately 160 small-holder members of the comon yaj noptic cooperative. the name of the cooperative translates to "all of us think", a philosophy that encourages its members to be individuals, question established practices, and seek knowledge to help them in their quest to grow organic coffee.

the cooperative was started in 1995, and acheived organic certification in 2003. though mexico is not often thought of for high quality microlots, the land farmed by comon yaj noptic is only a little ways from huehuetenango, a region of guatemala famed for it's unique coffees.

this coffee is grown between 1200 and 1750 meters. it is fully washed, and consists of typica, caturra, and bourbon varieties.
