

kenya yara aa

this coffee comes to us from kiambu county, located just north of nairobi. while coffees from the central highlands of kenya may be more visible and mainstream, some fantastic coffees are coming out of the south. this yara is a great example!

this is actually a large estate coffee, from an estate that was established during british rule quite some time ago, and was given over to the community there when kenya declared its independence. the community created the gatatha farmers cooperative, and inherited a well-run operation, with some unusual and fantastic processing equipment. they've continued the tradition of producing some of the best and most distinct coffees to come out of kiambu.

this coffee is grown at an average height of 1645 meters, and is fully washed with wet fermentation and raised bed drying. it consists of sl-28, sl-34, and ruiru 11 varieties. it is screened to aa sizing.
