

# colombia el aguacate decaf

this is our second purchase of one of the most interesting decafs we've ever had! way back in 2005, a coffee from a farm called "el aguacate" won the cup of excellence competition. however, it turned out that this "single farm" was actually a collection of 19 farmers from nariño! they went on to form a cooperative called asociación creciendo con el campo. it now consists of 30 farmers who produce an average of 100 bags of coffee per year. often, we see coffees that don't quite make the quality cut relegated to decaf. not here. this is a truly special coffee.

this particular coffee is grown at 1700 - 2000 meters, and consists of caturra, castillo, and colombia varieties. it is fully washed on farm, with tank fermentation and parabolic drying on raised screens or screened floors, and screened to excelso grade.
