ethiopia hambela dari

strawberry | watermelon | honey | lychee



this coffee comes to us from the guji area of oromia in ethiopia. in the past, this coffee has been funneled through the ethiopia commodities exchange, and it was difficult to trace. however, changes in regulations are finally allowing the owner of hambela washing station (buno general trading, owned by abiyot) to export coffees directly, and increase the traceability.

this particular lot comes from approximately 450 farmers from around a single selection site called dari kidame. abiyot has a reputation for providing fair off-season financing, and allowing repayment via coffee cherry. a collection of employees help him find the best cherry, and inform him of what he should buy and when, to create the best possible lots.

this coffee is grown between 1950 and 2100 meters, and consists of heirloom varieties. the bean size is uniformly small, owing to the consistent bi-modal rain pattern. this is a naturally processed coffee, with drying on raised beds.
