“los ídolos” refers to “el alto de los ídolos”, an archeological site containing the remnants of burial sites of a pre-colombian civilization known as san agustín. 68 farmers from around this area in huila joined to create grupo asociativo san agustín los cauchos. the goal for the cooperative is to obtain better prices for their coffee by working to increase the overall quality of their beans. so far, the group has worked to standardize practices amongst the members, and to increase the quality of their processing facilities and drying patios. this decaf is a great example of the quality they've been working hard to grow.

this particular coffee is grown at 1600 - 1900 meters, and consists of typica and caturra varieties. it is fully washed, with full sun-drying. it is decaffeinated using a european ea process.
