this offering comes to us from a tiny, little farm in the cauca region of colombia. senor ciro camayo grew up in a coffee producing family, but strayed when he started his own farm, focusing on growing fique, a fibrous plant used in the manfacture of jute. in 2007, ciro and his wife decided to take a chance, and planted 1,000 castillo coffee trees on a small portion of the 3 hectare farm. finding success, they then took the leap, and planted another 7000 trees, dedicating 100% of their efforts to coffee.

their choice of planting the castillo variety wasn't unusual, given the country's push to plant these diseaseresistant, robusta-derived varieties. but we find castillo in particular to have have some amazing, unique attributes. this lot certainly doesn't disappoint!

this coffee is fully washed on farm, with 18 hours of dry fermentation, and 10 days of raised bed drying under parabolic tents. it is grown at 2000 meters, and consists of 100% castillo variety.
