el jutal is a very small, family farm owned by salvador santos martinez. comprising just 2.8 hectares, the farm resides near belén gualcho in the ocotepeque department. salvador raises multiple crops on the farm, including grains, vegetables, blackberries, peaches, poultry, and other livestock. truly a family affair, all work on the farm is done by family members, helping to keep profits within the family. although salvador has been growing coffee for 21 years, it was mostly commercial grade at first. starting in 2008, salvador planted the newest varieties, and focused on quality. we're glad he did. he also started working with a cooperative (cafescor) in order to obtain technical assistance and help with certifications. salvador has been certified organic in the past, but decided the cost didn't justify the increase in revenue. he still follows sustainable practices.

this coffee is grown at 1600 meters. it is a honey process, and consists of 100% ihcafe 90 cultivar.
