

# colombia buenos aires decaf

this is our first purchase from cofinet, a small exporter in colombia that specializes in unique processing methods. all their coffees are an exploration, and this particular coffee is no exception. this coffee comes from a farm near armenia in quindio called buenos aires, and is owned by jairo arcila, who happens to be the father of two of cofinet's founders, carlos and filipe! jairo has been in the coffee industry nearly his entire life, having recently retired as the mill manager for colombia's second largest exporter after over 40 years on the job!

jairo bought his first farm in 1987, and used this extra income to purchase several more. buenos aires is his most recent purchase, and we have to say the coffee is fantastic. what may be even more astounding is that fact that this coffee is decaffeinated! this may be the best decaf coffee we've ever purchased.

this particular coffee is grown between 1200 - 1700 meters, and consists of 100% castillo cultivar. it is a full natural, with careful picking and hand-sorting, followed by temperature controlled drying on raised beds.
