## ethiopia raro nensebo espresso profile

a new purchase for us, from the guji region of ethiopia! raro nensebo is the name of a washing station located in uraga, guji, and is owned and operated by sookoo coffee. sookoo is run by ture waji, known as "the king of guji". having grown up in the area, ture has a deep connection to the land. having learned the export and processing management business at his cousin's farm, and following the liberalization of export laws in ethiopia, ture started sookoo and exported his first lot in 2018. he now provides technical assistance, pre-harvest loans, employs a "women-first" philosophy at his washing stations, and has financed both roads and a school.

this particular lot comes from 15 farmers in the village of raro majoo, and each farm is about 2.5-3 hectares in size. the farms sit between 2100 and 2350 meters, and the lot was named "qabballe" internally, which translates to "cold", and describes the growing conditions on farm. the coffee consists 74110 and 74112 varieties, and is naturally processed, with 21-28 of drying on raised beds with a maximum bed depth of 4 centimeters.
