

peru lima coffee women producers

this is a fair trade certified™, organic **dark-roasted** grown in the chirinos and ihuamaca zones of jaen, in the cajamarca region of peru. the coffee is grown by approximately 110 families led by female members of the asociacion de productores agropecuarios lima coffee peru, known as limcof, or lima coffee. we've been buying from lima coffee for the past four years, and have found their coffee (especially their decafs!) to be incredibly tasty and consistent.

100% of the premiums from this coffee go directly to the women's group, with a significant amount going to a program for empowerment of women at work, a program for economic development, savings and investment, a program of leadership development and training, and a program for comprehensive well-being and gender equality. the coffee is grown between 1600 and 1900 meters, is fully washed, and consists of typica, caturra, bourbon, and catimor varieties. the coffee is generally dried on raised beds.
