burundi gahahe

it's been a couple of years since we had a burundi offering, and we couldn't be more excited to see it return! this coffee comes to us from the famous kayanza region in the north of burundi, near a town called gahahe. the gahahe washing station is owned by greenco, a company focused on farmer welfare and amazing coffee. the typical farmer in burundi has a half hectare of land or less, so working with a company that provides projects such as a health insurance program, animal husbandry assistance, youth unemployment programs, and technical assistance is important!

the gahahe washing station services about 1740 farmers, each of whom own on average a tenth of a hectare and only 240 trees! many trees are decades old, as the farm size prevents replacement of the trees as they age. we believe the age contributes to the overwhelming sweetness we find in the cup.

this particular lot is a washed process, with delivered cherries undergoing 12-24 hours of wet fermentation, 2 hours of cleaning water rinsing, and 20 days of drying on raised beds. farms sit at an average of 1800 meters, and lots are created through the selection and blending of day lots. this lot consists of 100% bourbon variety.
