nguisse nare purchased setame, the primary farm of this offering, four years ago, with a strict focus on producing high quality coffee. nguisse processes coffee from setame, two other farms that he owns, and a collection of 60 out-growers from lands surrounding the farm, all located in the bensa woreda of sidama, near kokose. perhaps the most unique aspect of the farm is the altitude: setame sits at 2300 meters above sea level, an astoundingly high level.

nguisse focuses on producing natural and anaerobic coffees, and the high altitude contributes to the outstanding clarity and cleanliness we find in this natural offering. in fact, we actually see some florals and complexity that is normally found in the best washed coffees from ethiopia.

this coffee is grown between 2240 and 2300 meters and consists of 100% 74158 variety (a cataloged ethiopian heirloom variety). it is naturally processed, with a flotation sorting, followed by sun-drying slowly on raised beds over 20 days.
