
kenya ibonia

the ibonia estate is located in lesser known kiambu county, just three miles away from kiambu town. owned and operated by coffee management services, the farm is run by the ibonia farmers cooperative, comprising about 200 workers during harvest. only about 40% of the large, ~200 hectare farm is dedicated to coffee production, with the remaining land preserved. encompassing natural forest, wetlands, and rivers, the farm is home to an abundance of wildlife.

coffee management services provides support to both cooperatives and smallholder farmers across kenya. they focus on several avenues, including providing smallholders access to market, engaging in training and certification to support sustainability, and providing traceability to consumers through geomapping. they also are providing support for adaptation to climate change, encouraging gender and youth integration, and supporting the right to food security.

this coffee is grown at 1700 meters and consists primarily of the sl-28 cultivar, with lesser amounts of sl-34 and ruiru 11. it is fully washed, with raised bed drying. this is considered a "day lot", week 12 harvest, and screened to ab sizing. total lot size was a mere 45 bags.
