

honduras la unión women producers

this is a fair trade certified™, organic **dark-roast** grown in the marcala region of honduras. la unión is a 136 member cooperative, with 100% of the members belonging to the lenca ethnic group. within this group is a collection of 30 female producers, the growers of this particular offering. this group pools their wages each month to make small-scale loans to other members, helping to manage pre-crop financing, lot separation, and the distribution of post-harvest premiums. in short, these women are the real backbone of the cooperative.

la unión receives help from another cooperative called pacayal, which was founded in 2012 following a devastating outbreak of coffee leaf rust by edgar carrilo. pacayal helps primarily with technical assistance, having originally received training from sustainable harvest.

this coffee is grown between 1300 and 1500 meters, is fully washed, and consists of catuai, parainema, and ihcafe 90 varieties.
