the muburi coffee factory (washing station) is located in the village of rwama, located northeast of kianyaga, in kirinyaga county. muburi is one of three washing stations owned by the rwama farmer's cooperative society, the other two being muthigi-ini and kimatu. all these factories receive assistance from coffee management services, both from a technical perspective, and pre-harvest financing.

muburi serves the needs of a portion of the 1200 active members of rwama, those living in the surrounding villages of gituga, kiangoro, muburi, and kagukuma. they recently received new eco-pulpers through a grant from the european union and slovak aid, which helped significantly with their efficiency, as they're one of the few cooperatives who are continuing to see increases in delivered cherry.

muburi sits at 1600 meters, and this lot consists of 99% sl-28 cultivar, with a trace amount of ruiru 11. it is fully washed, with raised bed drying. this is considered a "day lot", week 14 harvest, and screened to ab sizing. total lot size was 65 bags.
