this is a fair trade certified, organic decaf coffee grown from members of the sierra azul cooperative in the buffer zone of the el triunfo biosphere in chiapas, mexico. smallholder members of this cooperative have modest farms, ranging from 2-5 hectares. the members are committed to not only producing organic coffees, but protecting the environment of the region.

chiapas is the southernmost region of mexico. much of this area is tropical forest comprising the protected triunfo biosphere reserve. humid and tropical, chiapas is inhabited by small communities of producers who have formed cooperatives like sierra azul to gain stronger representation in the coffee market, these producers take pride in their land, growing coffee organically through methods passed down from generation to generation.

this coffee is grown between 1000 and 1800 m.a.s.l. it is processed as a fully washed coffee and then decaffeinated using a mountain water process. the lot consists of bourbon, typica, and mundo novo varieties.
