this is a dark-roasted, fair trade certified[™] coffee that comes to us from the nyamasasa washing station, located in the highlands surrounding lake kivu. 4023 members of the sopacdi cooperative from the villages of ruhunde, kiniezire, bwisha, kalungu, nyamasasa, and kanenge all deliver cherry to this station. sopacdi is a rather large cooperative, based in minova, and consisting of 5600 members in total of multiple ethnic groups.

sopacdi was founded in 2003 by joachim munganga, a farmer himself, by restoring an old washing station in the area. this service helped provide market access to literally thousands of farmers. before sopacdi, farmers were often relegated to trading their coffee for food or supplies. with access to a much wider market, farmers can earn cash for their coffee, and with it, hope for a better future.

this coffee is grown at 1800 meters and consists of 100% bourbon variety. it is fully washed, with a double fermentation, and sun-drying on raised beds under net shade.
