Nova Dukorere Kawa's Story

Our third year purchasing coffee from the Nova Washing Station. This station services three co-ops, one of them being Dukorere Kawa. Each co-op consists of local smallholders in the Bukure sector of the Gicumba district. The station was started by Felix Hitayezu (a pharmacist) and his wife Agnes Mukamushinja (a nurse), who originally owned a Pharmacy also called Nova. Their goals of the Washing Station in their words are 'we envision to drive community socioeconomic welfare through the enhancement of improved coffee farming practices.'
