## Banko Taratu's Story

Our second year purchasing coffee from Banko Taratu. This village and washing station rests in the Gedeb district in the Gedeo Zone of Ethiopia. The village's washing station services some 500 local smallholders, where coffee cultivation is a local tradition. The station utilizes many processing and fermentation techniques. Last year we purchased a double fermentation washed process coffee, and this year, a honey processed coffee.
