Yaj Noptic's Story

Our second purchase from the Comon Yaj Noptic co-op in the El Triunfo Biosphere Reserve area of Chiapas, Mexico. This lot comes specifically from female members of the co-op. A premium is paid directly to these female members for the quality of this lot, aimed at promoting gender equality in the region. The term Comon Yaj Noptic means 'all of us think.' The group was formed in 1995 by smallholder farmers from Indigenous groups in the region. Today there are around 160 members.
