Kinini's Story

We've been purchasing coffee from Kinini for a few years, but this is the first year we've been able to offer coffee from a sub-group within the cooperative. The Dufatanye group consists of 60 women smallholders, all bringing their coffee to the Kinini Village Washing Station.

Kinini means "this big thing right here" and the project, founded by Jacque Turner, has accomplished big things indeed. The Washing Station and Cooperative service hundreds of producers in the area, and nearly 85% of them are women.
