Atunkaa's Story

Atunkaa means “dreaming or sleeping” in the Wayuunaiki language of Colombia. The program comes from the collaboration of our importing partners at Falcon Coffees with Siruma, and exporter in Colombia. Siruma means “heaven or skies” in the same Wayuunaiki language.

The program aims to bring traceability to the usual decaf system wherein the biggest margins are made by iimporters and exporters. In Atunkaa, the largest margins go to the coffee producers.
